This event is named in honor of Jasmine Andrea’ Sutton, “Jazzy” who was diagnosed with PWS-deletion at 7 years old. She is now 21 years old and currently resides at Foundations living care facility in New Paris, Ohio. Since admitted to Foundations over four years ago, she’s lost a total of 143lbs and maintaining, we’re so very proud of her progress. Jazzy is the daughter of Darrell and Julie Sutton of Dayton, Ohio. Julie is a member of the PWSA of Ohio Support Group and the event coordinator for this year’s “Jazzy’s Walk.” Although this event has Jazzy’s name in its title, rest assured that the funds raised from this event benefit all individuals with PWS, both here in Ohio and nationwide! The proceeds from this event will be split equally between PWSA(USA) and our State chapter, PWSA of Ohio. “Jazzy’s Walk” is a wonderful opportunity to increase both awareness of PWS and support for our children who live with its challenges on a daily basis.

What is Prader-Willi Syndrome? Prader-Will Syndrome is a complex genetic disorder which typically causes low muscle tone, short stature, cognitive disabilities, problem behaviors, and a chronic feeling of hunger which can lead to excessive eating and life-threatening obesity. Most cases of PWS are attributed to a spontaneous genetic error, involving the 15th chromosome, occurring at or near the time of conception for unknown reasons. The syndrome affects 1 in every 12-15,000 births, and although considered “rare” it is the most common genetic cause of obesity.
